PSO1	Academic Expertise: <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. Identify major movements and figures of English Literature.ii. Apply language studies with literature studies so that they will be able to place themselves in the job market.

The syllabus includes poems by famous nature poets like William Wordsworth, who stressed the importance the environment and also mentioned how mankind would perish if it did not conserve nature. ii. Various environmental issues are also dealt with in stories and poems which make up the syllabus. Students are encouraged to discuss these issues in the classroom and write about their experiences. This spreads awareness and incites a healthy debate about environmental practices.

They are expected to submit assignments and projects on various topics throughout their course. Actively surfing through various academic websites for data and collating information is encouraged. ii. PPTs are presented and assignments are often typed out and submitted online.
